School Site Council Minutes
Sep 14, 2023

Chairperson Allison Blankenship called the School Site Council Meeting to order on September 14, 2023, at 3:15 pm in Room 22.

Members present included: Allison Blankenship, Terry Brewer , Heather Cervantes , Rachel Oates , Kristi Wilson and Terri Gard. With 6 members present there was enough for a quorum. Isaiah Warren and Terri Gard are the current parent representatives. Melissa Wilson's and Jessica Bishop's terms are up.

Allison provided information on the history, requirements, and responsibilities of our School Site Council. Our enrollment has dipped under 300 students, classifying us as a small school. New rules will require us to have 3 parent representatives on the School Site Council. Additionally, two meetings will have student council members present for student representation. Their attendance will be a requirement for next year.

New officers were elected. Chairperson is Allison Blankenship , Vice Chairperson is Rachel Oates, Secretary is Kristi Wilson .

With our new small school classification, our meetings do not need to be monthly unless needed. The meeting dates were set.

Nov 9, 2023 (We will review CAASPP data, 1st quarter MAP, and gather questions for the parent survey).

Jan 11, 2023 (First Interim Budget Review and develop a community survey)

Mar 14, 2023 (Develop/Revise New Goals based on survey and other academic data.)

May 9, 2023 (Look at our draft, LCAP is due to the county July 1, 2024.)

We have 3 goals. Our Whole Child goal is being met as more clubs are being added to our After School Program. Our SEL goal is being met with our Wellness Center. Our Academic goal is far from being met. 80% of our students are not where they need to be. Our main focus will be to grow our academic program.

Ideas to prioritize academic funding include: parent engagement, art/music program, shift/change curriculum, professional development, and a tutoring program. Additional ideas included: adding leveled instruction in math, small group instruction, matching curriculum and vocabulary to be consistent with the test, continue expert groups to

enhance areas, use sprinting or 'HIIT model' and then take a quick break to build endurance in rigorous tasks.

Provide consistent parent communication-fewer methods so parents aren't being flooded with messages.

Rewards were discussed to motivate students to do well on their tests, strive for good grades, and improve attendance: during testing week provide celebrations, recognition for individual achievement, honor roll fun field trips, pizza, Waterworks, attendance recognition at assemblies and incentives for growth among classes and individuals.

Next meeting will be on November 9th.

Allison adjourned the meeting at 4:17 pm.
